DIED OF WOUNDS.

Lce-Corpl. Ralph Greenen, Hampshire Regt., third son of Mr. and Mrs. G. Greenen, 37 Holyrood-street, Newport. Lce-Corpl was reported missing in Italy in October last, and died of wounds whilst in enemy hands on November 30th. He was buried in the cemetery at Sora, Italy*. He was 23 years of age, and before joining the Army was an active worker at Bethany-hall, Newport, where he had been a Sunday-school teacher for several years. He had shown remarkable promise as a preacher, and his quiet unassuming ways and fine Christian character made him greatly beloved by his fellow workers and the children of the Sunday-school.
