The Late Mr. L. B. Berridge.- Mr. Leslie Bertram Berridge, aged 54, of 78 Worsley Road, died at St. Mary's Hospital on Friday week. Mr. Berridge was born in the town and served in the Wiltshire Regiment, and during the second world war in the Welch Regiment. For the last 10 years he had been a civilian employee at Albany Barracks. He was a member of the committee of the local branch of the British Legion. He is survived by his wife, three sons, and three daughters. The funeral service was held at the house on Tuesday, conducted by Fr. Murphy O'Connor, and interment followed at Carisbrooke Cemetery. The mourners were Mrs. E. T. Berridge (widow), Messrs. R., P., and P. Berridge (sons), Misses M. E., S. J., and A. Berridge (daughters), Mrs. Cole (sister), Mrs. H. R. E. Berridge (sister-in-law), Mrs. D. Huxley (cousin), Mr. C. Berridge (nephew), and representatives of the E.T.U., British Legion, and workmates, who also sent floral tributes.
