Obituary.

- Another resident of West-street, Mr. Frederick Burt, brother of Mrs. S. E. Leigh, with whom he had lived for many years, and son of the late Mr, H. Burt, carrier, of Orchard-street, died on Sunday at the age of 61. He was a familiar figure in the town as an assistant at the Market, and member of the Liberal Club. In his early days he was prominent as a high-jumper in the local sports and was a runner with the I.W. Foxhounds. The funeral was on Thursday, the service being at St, John's Church and the interment at Carisbrooke. The Vicar of Carisbrooke (the Rev. H. Ewbark) officiated, and the chief mourners were Mrs. S. E. Leigh (sister), Mr. E. Shephard (brother-in-law), Messrs. C. Shephard and E. S. and C. G. Leigh (nephews) and G. Burt (cousin), Mrs. Shephard (sister) was unavoidably prevented from attending.
