Death of Mr. C. W. Cooke. – The death occurred at 42 West Street on Monday of Mr. Charles Walter Cooke, aged 76. Mr. Cooke a native of Arreton was for 20 years an employee of Messrs. H. W. Wooldridge and Co., and before that he worked for Messrs. H. W. Morey and Sons, Ltd. He had been living by himself since the death of his wife some three years ago. The funeral service took place on Wednesday at St. John's Church, the Vicar (the Rev. S. F. Cooper) officiating. The mourners were Mr. G. Cooke (brother), Mr. G. Rice (brother-in-law), Miss M. Rice (niece), and Mr. C. Upward. Those present included Messrs. W. C. A. Eyles and A. H. Dallimore, representing Messrs. J. W. Wooldridge and Co. The floral tributes included those from the staff of Messrs. Wooldridge and the neighbours of West Street. The interment was at Carisbrooke Cemetery. Messrs. O. C. Hamilton and Son were the undertakers.
