Death of Mr. F. W. Guy. – The death occurred on Sunday at 55 Elm Grove, of Mr. Frederick William Guy, aged 76. He came to the Island about 25 years ago from Ringwood, and until his retirement in 1946 was employed as a millwright by Messrs. Leigh Thomas and Co. Ltd. Mr. and Mrs. Guy celebrated their golden wedding at Christmas, 1950. He was a regular worshipper at the Congregational Church, where the funeral service took place on Thursday. The Rev. Dr. Norman Spoor (minister) officiated, and Mr. Guy's favourite hymns, "Eternal Light" and "Peace, perfect peace," were sung. The mourners were Mrs. E. Guy (widow), Mr. and Mrs. R. H. Guy (son and daughter-in-law), Mr. and Mrs. R. Stapleton (son-in-law and daughter), Miss R. Guy (sister), and Mr. J. Betts (grandson). Among the large congregation were representatives of the P.T.E., Messrs. H. F. Payn, T. Sanders, and F. Cave (representing Messrs. Leigh Thomas and Co. Ltd.), and Mr. L. Nicholls (representing Sheath and Co.). The floral tributes included those from Leigh Thomas and Co., Ltd., and the neighbours of Elm Grove. The interment was at Carisbrooke Cemetery. Messrs. O. C. Hamilton and Son made the arrangements.
