SUDDEN DEATH. - On Tuesday morning Miss Mary Hayles (sic), an old woman, who kept the Registrar's Office, at Carisbrooke-road, Newport, was found dead in bed. On the previous evening she was in her usual health. In the morning her sister, finding that she was rather late in coming downstairs, went into her bedroom and found her quite dead. It was not considered necessary to hold an inquest on the body, as Dr. Dabbs certified that death was caused by disease of the lungs.
