Death of Mr. A. Hayles.- The death occurred at his home, 172 Carisbrooke Road, on Friday week of Mr. Alfred Hayles, aged 77. A native of the Island, he served in the Army for 17 years. In 1918 he took employment with the Portland Cement Company as a labourer, retiring during the last war. The funeral service took place on Tuesday, at Carisbrooke Cemetery. The Rev. S. F. Cooper (vicar of St. John's Church) officiated. The family mourners included Mrs. F. E. Hayles (widow), Miss M. Hayles (daughter), Mr. and Mrs. A. Hayles (son and daughter-law), and Mr. and Mrs. R. Rice (son-in-law and daughter). Among the floral tributes were three from Messrs. F. W. Woolworth, the Waverley Hotel and neighbours. Messrs. O. C. Hamilton and Son made the arrangements.
