Nonagenarian's Death. – The death occurred on Friday week at Dilton, Alvington-road, of Mrs. Emily Hillier, widow of Mr. G. Hillier, aged 90. A native of Thorley¹, Mrs. Hillier had resided her with her daughter, Mrs. E. Hendy, for about 14 years, but for practically all that time had been confined to her bed.
