Death of Miss D. L. Minns.- The death took place on Saturday of Miss Dorothy Leonore Minns, of 54 St. John's Road, aged 74. Miss Minns was a nurse in France during the first world war, and in 1925 she joined the local British Cross Society, Voluntary Aid Detachment, and eventually became assistant commandant. She resigned in 1925. The funeral service took place on Thursday at the Parish Church, conducted by the vicar (the Rev. L. J. D. Wheatley), assisted by the vicar (the Rev. A. P. Lumley), The mourners were Miss K. Minns (sister), Miss M. Vanner (niece) and Mr. R. Goddard. Among wreaths was one sent by the local Voluntary Aid Detachment. Arrangements were made by Messrs. O. C. Hamilton and Son.
