

Tertius Edward Cyril Nobbs

Death of Mr. T. E. C. Nobbs. - The death occurred suddenly at his home, 1 South View, on Tuesday week of Mr. Tertius Edward Cyril Nobbs, aged 52, an aircraft fitter at Messrs. Saunders-Roe, Ltd., where he had worked for 30 years. Mr. Nobbs was a keen member of Newport F.C. Supporters' Club. He was also a member of the Amalgamated Engineering Union. Sympathy is felt for his wife and two sons. The high esteem in which he was held was reflected by the large congregation at the funeral at St. Thomas's Church on Friday week. The service was conducted by the Vicar (the Rev. C. R. Farnsworth) and the Rev. W. H. Price. Representatives of the Amalgamated Engineering Union and Saunders-Roe's branches at Cowes, Osborne, and Parkhurst Forest were present, as well as friends and neighbours. The mourners were Mrs. Nobbs (widow), Mr. and Mrs. G. Nobbs (son and daughter-in-law), and Mr. M. Nobbs (son), Mr. and Mrs. A. Nobbs (brother and sister-in-law), Mr. and Mrs. C. Brown (brother-in-law and sister), Mr. N. Nobbs (nephew), Messrs. E., A., and S. Fleming and T. Nobbs (uncles), Mrs. Atkey, Miss Nobbs, and Mrs. P. Verey (cousins), Mrs. C. Cave (aunt), Mrs. H. C. Taylor (representing Mr. Taylor, cousin), Messrs. L. Padwick, C. Russell, Gaynor, and M. Bull and Mr. and Mrs. G. Burton. There were 40 floral tributes. The interment was at Carisbrooke Cemetery. The arrangements were by Messrs. O. C. Hamilton and Son.
