**Market Gardener's Death.** – The death occurred on Monday of Mr. James Henry Salter, aged 80, of Ash Lane, Gunville, a well-known market gardener. Born in Newport, he had lived in the district all his life and was a familiar figure conveying his produce to town in his horse and cart. He was a member of the Earl Yarborough Lodge of Odd Fellows. Mr. Salter's wife died 18 months ago and he is survived by two sons. The funeral took place on Thursday, the service at the Carisbrooke Cemetery Chapel being conducted by the Minister of the Victoria Methodist Church (the Rev. C. Cardy). The mourners were Mr. F. G. Salter (son), Mr. and Mrs. A. Brewer (son-in-law and daughter), Mr. and Mrs. E. Salter, Mr. and Mrs. H. Brewer, and Mr. and Mrs. V. E. Constable (grandchildren). Messrs. O. C.
