THE LATE MRS. C. SHEATH

The funeral service took place at Quay Street Methodist Church on Monday for Mrs. Catherine Sheath, aged 89, of The Glen, 14 Caesars Road, who died on Wednesday week. The Rev. Dr. W.H. Mildon officiated. Mrs. Sheath was the widow of Mr. C.J. Sheath, who formerly carried on the corn merchant's business of E. Way and Co., in Quay Street. She was born in Ryde and came here after her marriage about 64 years ago, living in Caesars Road, although not in the same house. Her younger son, Percy, was killed during the last war when the Fire Station at Shanklin was bombed. One of her daughters died four years ago. She leaves a daughter and two sons.

The mourners were Miss E. Sheath (daughter), Mr. and Mrs. W.H. and Mr. and Mrs. A.T. Sheath (sons and daughters-in-law), Miss Ann Sheath (granddaughter), Mr. and Mrs. K. Hosking and Mrs. Wilson-Chalon (nephew and nieces), Nurse Cooper, Mrs. Harding, Mrs. L.W. Downer and Mrs. Davis. The floral tributes included those from neighbours of Caesars Road and Quay Street Methodist Church. Interment was at Carisbrooke Cemetery. Messrs. Moorman and Sons made the arrangements.
