Funeral of Mrs. A. R. Sivier.--Mrs. Alice Rose Sivier, aged 65, a former resident of Brighstone and Yarmouth, died at the home of her daughter at 13 Castle Road, on Sunday. Mrs. Sivier was a native of the town, but was best known at Brighstone, where she spent most of her married life. She was a worshipper at the Baptist Church before she left the district. Sincere sympathy is felt with her husband, sons, and daughters. Although only 65, she had 12 grandchildren. The funeral was on Wednesday. The Minister (the Rev. W. H. Price) officiated at the service at the Baptist Church and the hymn "Love, Divine," was sung. The mourners were Mr. and Mrs. C., Mr. and Mrs. F., Mr. and Mrs. A., and Mr. and Mrs. R.
