**DEATH OF MRS. A.E.M. SMITH**

The death occurred at Polars House, Staplers Road, Newport, on Thursday week of Mrs. Alison Evelyn May (Queenie) Smith, aged 81, of 122 Hunnyhill. Mrs. Smith was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. G.D. Pardey. She attended Parkhurst school and was then in domestic service with the Wavell family in Holyrood Street. Mrs. Smith was married in 1914 to Mr. Albert Arthur Smith of Portland Street, who was employed at the former cement mills at West Medina until his death in 1943. She was a lifelong worshipper with the Salvation Army until becoming housebound by ill health ten years ago. She had been a patient at St. Mary's Hospital, following a fall at her home, but had been a resident at Polars for a month. The funeral service took place at Newport cemetery on Thursday and Mr. F. Lloyd made the arrangements.
