The late Miss M. Stotesbury. – The funeral took place on Saturday of Miss Marjorie Stotesbury, third daughter of Mr. and Mrs. W. Stotesbury, 64 Whitepit-lane, who died at the County Hospital on Tuesday week, aged 27. She was a nurse at Forest House before becoming a student nurse at the Royal I.W. County Hospital and was held in high esteem by all at both institutions. The interment took place at Carisbrooke, following a service in St. Thomas's Church, Canon W. B. Hogg officiating. The mourners included Mr. and Mrs. W. Stotesbury (parents), Mr. J. and Pte. C. Stotesbury (brothers), Mr. H. Dore, L.A.C. W. J. and Miss J. Stotesbury (sisters), Mr. and Mrs. H. Worthey (sister and brother-in-law), Mr. G. J. Stotesbury, junr., and Pte. J. Stotesbury (representing Mr. G. J. Stotesbury, who was prevented by illness from attending), Mr. and Mrs. W. Parsons (aunts and uncles), Miss L. Dobson (cousin), the matron, sisters, and nurses of the Royal I.W. County Hospital, and former colleagues from Forest House, Parkhurst. Gunners W. E. and K. G. Stotesbury and Sergt. H. Dore (brothers and brother-in-law) were prevented from attending by war service. Over 40 beautiful floral tributes were received ...
