DEATH OF A SCHOOLBOY. – The sad news of the sudden death of Frederick George Talbot, son of Mrs. Talbot, of Carisbrooke, at the County Hospital on May 17th, at the early age of 13 years, came as a great shock to his many relatives and friends. He was only ill six days. The funeral took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Friday week the service at the church and graveside being conducted by the Rev. Father Doran. There were 24 floral tributes, including one “From the teachers and scholars of Carisbrooke Council School, a token of high esteem.” The whole school kept silence for two minutes at the time fixed for the interment as a mark of respect for their late schoolfellow. - The relatives of the late Frederick George Talbot wish to tender their heartfelt thanks to the matron, doctors, and nurses of the County Hospital, also neighbours and friends for kind inquiries and sympathy shown in their terrible loss, and also for beautiful flowers sent.
