DEATH OF MR. H. W. TAYLER. – The death took place after a long and painful illness, at 38 Orchard-street on Wednesday week of Mr. Henry William Tayler, aged 63, a native of the borough, who was well known as a fish and fruit wholesale dealer and travelling salesman. Although his education was very meagre Mr. Tayler had great business aptitude, and for many years he controlled quite a considerable trade in the food stuffs mentioned, being much esteemed for his upright methods of business and for numerous acts of generosity quietly done. The funeral took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Sunday, the Rev. D. Hendy Davies officiating. In addition to his children and other relatives whose attending included Messrs. E. A. Walmsley (local manager of F. Trim and Co.), J. and E. Kirby, W. Rugg, H. Andrews, Nicholls, F. Chiverton, F. Sheaf, A. Dear, and other business acquaintances of the deceased. There were about 25 beautiful floral tributes, including those from the directors and the local manager and staff of F. Trim and Co., and one from the neighbours at Orchard-street. Mr. O. C. Hamilton made the arrangements.
