NEWPORT

The Late Mr. E. J. Urry. – The funeral took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Saturday of Mr. Ernest James Urry, aged 75, late of Scarrott's Lane. Mr. Urry, who was well known as a former newspaper roundsman, died at St. Mary's Hospital on the previous Wednesday. The Rev. L. J. D. Wheatley (Church of England chaplain at St. Mary's) officiated at the service in the Carisbrooke Cemetery Chapel. Mr. F. Chiverton represented the Church Council and Mrs. G. E. Mills the congregation of St. Thomas's Church, where Mr. Urry attended. A wreath was sent from the Vicar, churchwardens, and members of the congregation. At the meeting of the St. Thomas's Bible Class on Sunday, Mr. A. D. Callaway (vice-president) referred to Mr. Urry's death.
