Mrs. C. M. Verry.- The funeral took place at Carisbrooke Parish Church on Thursday of Mrs. Constance Mary Verry, 77, of 28 Castle Road, who died at her home the previous Sunday after a long illness. Born in Newport, Mrs. Verry lived in Southampton for 36 years, returning to the Island in 1959. She was the widow of Mr. P. A. Verry. She had been chairman of the Bitterne Park and St. Denys Townswomen's Guilds and served in a similar capacity for Newport Afternoon T.G. She was also a member of Carisbrooke Women's Institute. Mrs. Verry is survived by a son, Brother Francis Verry of Quarr, and a brother, Mr. J. Taylor. The funeral service was conducted by the Rev. W. M. A. Potts, and the Abbott of Quarr, the Rt. Rev. A. Sillem, read the committal sentences. Mourners included Brother Francis Verry (son), Mr. J. Taylor (brother), Mrs. H. Middleton (cousin), Mr. F. W. Padwick (brother-in-law), Mrs. E. Taylor (sister-in-law), Mrs. M. Strong (god-daughter), and Mr. A. E. Chard. Miss Padwick (niece) was unable to attend. Organisations represented were Newport Afternoon Townswomen's Guild, Carisbrooke Women's Institute, St. Michael's Church, Southampton, and Quarr Abbey. Messrs. R. G. W. Reed made the arrangements.
