MR. C. P. DAMP DIES AT 76

MR. CHARLES PERCY DAMP, who managed the former builders and funeral directors of H. and F. Damp Ltd., of Pyle-street, Newport, has died, aged 76.

Mr. Damp, of Medina Avenue, Newport, was born and educated in Newport. After working for two years in Canada in the early 1920's, he joined the family firm as an apprentice carpenter.

Mr. Damp managed the business for many years until his retirement in 1974, when it was sold.

During the last war, he served with the Hampshire Regiment.

He was a former chairman of the Trustees of the Trustee Saving Bank and a member of the Albany Lodge of Freemasons, the Independent Order of Oddfellows, the Royal British Legion and the IW County Club.

Mr. Damp leaves a widow and three daughters. The funeral service took place on Wednesday at St. John's Church, Newport.
