**DEATH OF MRS. J. GILBERT.** – A large company of friends, particularly in the Parkhurst district, where she spent the greater part of her life and was held in high esteem, will share the sorrow of her family in the death of Mrs. Frances Gilbert, of Crichel, Elm-grove, who passed away at the County Hospital on Wednesday, at the age of 60. Mrs. Gilbert was the widow of Mr. James Gilbert, ex-chief officer at the Camp Hill Borstal Institution and formerly of the Parkhurst Prison Staff, who died suddenly just over a year ago, five years after his retirement. She had been in failing health since Christmas, but had only been seriously ill for about a month. She succumbed following an operation, leaving three sons and three daughters. The deceased was a daughter of the late Mr. James Hayles, a Parkhurst Prison officer. The funeral takes place this (Saturday) afternoon; service at St. John's Church at 2.30.
