### NEWPORT.

**Well known Dairyman's Death.** – After a long illness the death took place on Saturday of Mr. William Henry Thomas Stark, aged 72, a well known dairy farmer, of Upper St. Cross, Dodnor. He was one of the pioneers of clean milk production and was also known for his great success in horse breaking. His family have been connected with St. Cross since 1803. He is survived by his wife, two sons, and a daughter. He lost a son in each of the world wars. The funeral took place on Tuesday at Carisbrooke. The mourners were Mrs. A. H. Stark, Messrs. R. and E. Stark (sons), Mrs. P. Rogers (daughters), Mr. A. Stark (brother), Mr. H. Stark (nephew), Mrs. Rolf (sister), and Mrs. Harvey (representing Mrs. J. Roach). The arrangements were by Mr. O. C.
