

Thomas Henry William Cassidy

Funeral of Mr. T. Cassidy. – Representatives of the prison service and the Conservative Association attended the funeral service at St. Mary's Church on Monday, conducted by the Vicar (the Rev. D. S. McKenzie), of Mr. Tom Cassidy, of Elmhurst, Priory Road, whose death occurred suddenly on Wednesday week. Because of ill-health Mr. Cassidy had to retire from his position as steward of Camp Hill prison two years ago. He had had a long career in the prison service, serving at Pentonville and Holloway and Usk before becoming chief administrative officer at Camp Hill some seven years ago. The family mourners were Mrs. L. Cassidy (widow) and her daughter and son-in-law. The Conservative Association were represented by Capt. H. A. Drudge (secretary and agent), Miss P. Brannon, Mesdames Brown, Hoare, Scott, Jolliffe, Simpkins, and Dudley, and the Camp Hill prison by the Governor (Mr. A. C. Packham), several members of the staff and retired prison officers from the Camp Hill and Parkhurst. Cremation followed at Southampton.
