The Late Mrs. W. L. Barlow.--The death occurred on Monday, at her home, 52 Linden Road, of Mrs. Kate Barlow, aged 70, widow of Mr. William Leonard Barlow, who died in 1938. Mrs. Barlow had been in failing health for a considerable time. She had spent most of her life in domestic service and was employed for many years by Mr. and Mrs. W. G. Sibbick, Capt. H. A. Drudge, M.B.E., and Mrs. Drudge, the I.W. Conservative Association, and for the last two years at the County Hall. She leaves a son and daughter. The funeral took place on Thursday at St. Thomas's Church, the Vicar (the Rev. A. P. Lumley) officiating. Interment followed in the grave of her husband in Newport Cemetery. The mourners were Mr. and Mrs. W. Bulpitt (son-in-law and daughter), Mr. and Mrs. H. Barlow (son and daughter-in-law), Mr. R. Martin (son-in-law), Mr. and Mrs. P. O'Neill, Miss J. Martin, and Mr. D. Bulpitt (grandchildren), Mrs. J. Churn (niece), Mr. R. Warder (nephew), Miss M. Tutton, and Mr. M. Wenham.
