Former Drayman's Death.- The death occurred on Thursday week, at 178 Carisbrooke Road, of Mr. Frank Arthur Chiverton, aged 74, formerly of Faydale, Fairlee Road. For 47 years Mr. Chiverton was employed as a drayman by Messrs. W. B. Mew, Langton and Co. at the Royal Brewery, retiring three years ago. He served in the 1914-18 war, and while his health permitted was a member of the local branch of the British Legion. The funeral service at the Congregational Church on Monday was conducted by the Minister (the Rev. Dr. N. Spoor). The mourners were Mrs. A. F Chiverton (widow), Mrs. V. Dunny (step-daughter), Mesdames E. Gladdis and K. Holbrook and Miss K. Chiverton (nieces), and Mrs. Pitman. Mr. A. Chiverton (brother), was unable to attend because of illness. The interment was at Newport Cemetery. Messrs. H. and F. Damp made the arrangements.
