## **NEWPORT**

**DEATH OF AN OLD INHABITANT.** – We have to record the death of one of the oldest inhabitants of Newport – Mr. William Dashwood, who passed away on Wednesday last, at the fine old age of 92. The deceased gentleman was for some years a member of the Corporation of Newport, and attained the dignity of an alderman of the borough. He possessed highly artistic tastes, not simply as a connoisseur, but also as a painter, and there were few who surpassed him in his knowledge of heraldry – always a favourite study with him. He celebrated his 92<sup>nd</sup> birthday on Tuesday last, and on the following day death summoned him hence, so snapping yet another of the few remaining links connecting the present with the past, and removing from amongst us one who throughout his long life commanded the respect and esteem of all who knew him.
