The Late Mrs. A. Newnham.- The death occurred suddenly on Friday week of Mrs. F. Newnham, of 63 Hunnyhill. She was a member of St. Andrew's Mothers' Union, the Wesleyan Sisterhood, the Co-operative Guild, and the women's section of the British Legion. She had been in indifferent health for some time. The funeral took place on Tuesday, the service being held at the Victoria Methodist Church, the Rev. J. L. Stafford officiating. The mourners were Mr. A. Newnham, Messrs. Ronald, Reginald, A., and H. Newnham (sons), Mesdames Pell and Saunders (daughters), Mrs. Knapp (niece), Messrs. Pell and Saunders (sons-in-law), Mrs. R.
