NEWPORT

A VETERAN WESLEYAN'S DECEASE. – On Tuesday last, Mr. John Shaw, a veteran member of the Wesleyan Church, of this town, passed away at the ripe age of 76. On Friday the interment took place at Newport Cemetery, the officiating ministers being the Revs. J. Shearman and J. Spensley. At 11 o'clock a short but impressive service was conducted in the chapel, it being attended by several of deceased's relatives, together with many friends from various districts in the Isle of Wight. The deceased was deservedly esteemed by all those with whom he came in contact. It may be mentioned that for upwards of fifty years he had fulfilled the duties of a local preacher with praise-worthy fidelity. On Sunday evening at the Wesleyan Chapel, Newport, the preacher (the Rev. J. Shearman) referred to the subject of this notice, and also to the recent decease of an aged member in a sympathetic and appropriate manner.
