DEATH OF MR. R. DIMENT. – The death occurred on Saturday at Palmers Cottage, of Mr. R. Diment, aged 72, for 38 years the much respected occupier of Little Fairlee Dairy, and a regular attendant at Newport market. A Somerset man, he was for some time at Brook before taking Little Fairlee, which he occupied until last Michaelmas, the sale of the farm in connection with the disposal of the Wykeham-Martin estate marking his retirement from business. The funeral took place on Tuesday, the first part of the service at the United Methodist Church, where the deceased was a regular worshipper, and the interment at Newport Cemetery, the Rev. T. Letcher officiating. The personal mourners were Messrs G. and A. Diment (sons), Mrs. Gosden (daughter), Mrs. G. Diment (daughter-in-law), Miss E. Gosden (grand-daughter), Mrs. Goslin (sister-in-law), Miss Davis (niece), and Mr. W. Goslin (nephew).
