NEWPORT

Much Sympathy—is felt with Mr. Arthur H. Dockrill, of the firm of Sir Francis Pittis and Son, and Mrs. Dockrill, of Broadlands, in the death of their daughter, Miss Muriel Florence Dockrill in her 15th year. She had suffered all her life from serious malformation, and was taken ill early in February and removed to the Hampstead General Hospital, London, six weeks ago. She gradually weakened, and passed peacefully away in her sleep on the 31st ult. Deceased was a promising pupil at Braunstone House School, and passed several examinations in music. The funeral took place on Wednesday, the first part of the service being at St. Thomas's Church, and the interment at Newport Cemetery, the Vicar (the Rev. C. H. Thompson) officiating. The principal mourners were the father and brother, and Messrs. J. and F. Starke. There were numerous floral tributes from the principals and scholars of Braunstone House School in addition to relatives and many other friends. The coffin was of polished oak, with silver-plated fittings. Mr. A. G. Hurry (St. John's Wood) and Messrs. H. and V. Damp were the undertakers.
