DEATH OF GEORGE WILLIAM TRENCHARD We regret to record the death, which took place early on Wednesday morning, after a lingering illness, of a well-known and esteemed townsman in the person of Mr. George F.W. Trenchard, of High-street. As long as health permitted the late Mr. Trenchard did his share of parish and municipal work. He had served for three years as a member of the Corporation, the performance of his duties being marked by much assiduity; and he had also done useful public work as an overseer of the poor and a member of the parish assessment committee. A staunch Conservative, the Unionist cause had in him a zealous supporter. He had been prominently identified with friendly society work, having passed through the chair of the Earl Yarborough Lodge of Oddfellows, and he was also an hon. Member of the local Court of Foresters. An ardent sportsman, he was ever to the fore in assisting the promotion of athletic and kindred competitions in the district, and he had for many years been a valued officer and supporter of the Carisbrooke Bowling Club, and a good bowler to boot. He was deputy captain of the Club at this death and formerly had ably filled the office of hon. secretary and hon. treasurer. His geniality and personal qualities won him a wide circle of friends, whose sincerest sympathies are with the widow and young family in their heavy bereavement.
