FORMER ASSISTANT POSTMASTER'S DEATH

The funeral service took place at St. Thomas's Church on Friday week for Mr. Clifford James Guy, aged 77, of 163 Staplers Road, who died at St Mary's Hospital on Tuesday week. Mr. Guy began a career in the Post Office at Ryde in 1904 and was transferred to Newport in 1908. He retired in 1947 after reaching the position of assistant head postmaster. During the 1914-18 war he served with the Royal Engineers in East Africa from 1916 to 1919. He was a member of the Newport Literary Society until it ceased to exist and a sideman at the Parish Church for many years.

The Rev. F. G. Fuller (vicar) officiated. The mourners were Mrs. Guy (widow) and Mrs. F. S. Hope (daughter). Mr. P. Guy (son), Captain F. S. Hope, R.N. (son-in-law) and Miss H. Guy (sister) were unable to attend. Interment was at St. Paul's Cemetery. Mr. A. E. Wyatt made the arrangements.
