Mr. N. Hall.- The funeral service took place at Newport Methodist Church of Mr. Nathaniel (Nat) Hall, of Bellecroft Drive, Staplers, Newport, who died at St. Mary's Hospital, Newport. He was 67. The Rev. P. Hanks conducted the service. Born in County Tyrone, Northern Ireland, Mr. Hall was educated in Ireland and Germany. He came to the Island 42 years ago and worked as a bus driver for the Southern Vectis Omnibus Company for almost 40 years. During the last war, he served with the Eight Army in the Western Desert. Mr. Hall leaves a widow and son. The church was full to capacity for the funeral service when mourners included relatives, friends and former colleagues. The Southern Vectis Sports and Social Club was also represented. Messrs. Hamilton and Marshall made the arrangements.
