**ODDFELLOW'S FUNERAL.** – The funeral of Bro. W. H. Bullock, of Staplers, took place on Sunday last at St. Paul's, Barton, the service being conducted by the Rev. W. H. Nutter. About 50 members of the Earl of Yarborough Lodge of Oddfellows, of which deceased was an old member, attended, amongst those present being Bros. J. Blake, N.G., T. H. Alexander, V.G., G. Morris, P.G., sick-pay officer, E. Whitcher, R.S., R. A. Saunders, C.S., J. Taylor, P.G., R. Howes, P.C., W. J. Rigg, P.G., F. B. Meager, P.G., W. Fuller, P.G., C. Steel, P.G., secretary, E. Stark, Woodward, Barnes, &c. At the close of the burial service, the Oddfellows' address was impressively read by the lecture master, Bro. F. B. Meager, the Rev. W. H. Nutter remaining at the grave during the reading of the same. The deceased's fellow workman sent a wreath and acted as bearers.
